Renewi wins contract with municipality of Cranendonck in the Netherlands

Renewi has won a five year waste collection contract with the municipality of Cranendonck, in the south of the Netherlands.

The waste-to-product company will be responsible for collecting all organic waste, residual waste, plastics, glass and other materials in the municipality as well as running a waste recycling point. Under the contract, Renewi will manage waste in the municipality from almost 21,000 citizens, over more than 8,000 households.

Renewi will work with the municipality over the next five years to increase the waste separation rate to be able to give new life to the used materials. The municipality will develop a waste policy plan, in conjunction with Renewi, to achieve its sustainability objectives, including increasing source separation of raw materials. Renewi is also deploying an extensive communication campaign, including a new website and waste app, to motivate and support the municipality's citizens in separating their waste. Mayor Ms M.M.D (Marga) Vermue – Vermue from Cranendonck said:

"In 2015, Cranendonck collected an average of 97 kilograms of domestic residual waste per resident, far less than the national average of 202 kilograms, while the separation percentage was approximately 81%. However, we as municipality of Cranendonck want to improve the collection and separation of domestic waste even further and within this contract we have set our target at 50 kilograms of residual waste per person per year in 2022. By working with Renewi, we have a partner with the greatest potential to support us and to realise this and other sustainability objectives. We look very much forward to working with Renewi".

Otto de Bont, Managing Director, Renewi Commercial Waste Netherlands said:

"We are very pleased to have won this five year contract with the municipality of Cranendonck. With our deep waste-to-product knowledge and expertise we will help Cranendonck to develop its waste policy and meet its sustainability goals, which will also benefit it's thousands of households. This will include optimising the collection procedure, educating its population and reducing residual waste. The contract win is also completely in



line with our strategy to further improve the overall recycling and recovery rate of our customers' waste streams."

Renewi currently services many Dutch municipalities where it collects domestic waste for around 1 million households.
